As a NextUp student, I understand that the program is designed to support me in achieving my academic and personal goals. I acknowledge that my success in college is a shared responsibility between myself and the NextUp program staff, and I am committed to fulfilling my responsibilities to the best of my ability.

I understand that I am eligible for NextUp services if I meet the following criteria:

- I was in foster care on or after my 13th birthday in any state.
- Enrolled in at least 1 unit with the intent to enroll in 9 units through an EdPlan.
- I was under the age of 26 at the time I first applied to the NextUp Program.

To set myself up for success and get the most out of the NextUp program to further my education and personal goals, I agree to the following:

- Attend at least <u>one meeting with an EOPS academic counselor</u> (in person or virtually) each semester to create or update my education plan and discuss my academic goals, celebrate my progress, and connect to campus and community resources.
- Attend at least <u>one meeting with my NextUp service provider</u> (in person or virtually) each semester to update them on my academic progress, celebrate my efforts, and identify strategies to better navigate school.
- 3. <u>Attend at least one NextUp event</u> (in person or virtually) each semester to expand my personal and professional network and connect with my campus community.

As a NextUp student, I can expect the following services and support from the program staff:

- Academic and personal therapy (email Vicky for an appointment at: vanavarro@pipeline.sbcc.edu)
- Access to priority registration and enrollment assistance
- Textbook assistance, a cafeteria meal plan, and other financial assistance as available
- Access to tutoring and academic support services
- Help applying for and accessing financial aid and scholarships
- Assistance with transfer planning and applications
- Connection and referrals to other resources that will help me succeed in school
- Being able to ask questions without fear of judgment
- Being treated with dignity and respect
- Community and belonging

While I possess strengths, resilience, talents, and a willingness to learn from others that will help me succeed, I am not alone on my educational journey. I am committed to my success and know that NextUp program staff are equally committed to seeing me succeed. I agree to reach out to access information and resources, ask questions, express concerns, engage with NextUp program staff, and fulfill my program responsibilities to the best of my ability. I understand that if I do not connect or communicate with my NextUp program staff, I am limiting the benefits I can receive from the program and may limit the program staff's ability to provide me with the best possible support.
