




## Where to find the application?

- 2. Scroll down to find the **Noncredit**Application located on the second red box




 To begin the Noncredit CCCApply application click on Noncredit CCCApply located under step 1

## **Creating Your Account**

- You can use an email address or your phone number to sign in. You will then receive a code to your email address or phone number that you will enter
- 2. Enter your **Personal Information** such as your legal first, middle and last name, suffix (if applicable), preferred name, date of birth, and home address
- 3. **Create a password** for your CCCApply account. Then, select create account
- 4. **SKIP Verify with ID.me** by clicking Verify later. Then select **yes**, **I want to opt out of ID.me**. If you want to verify your identity, you can select verify me. You will be redirected to the ID.me sign in page. **This is not a requirement as an SBCC student**

Colleges student account. You will receive a code via email to verify your identity and keep your account secure.






#### **Enrollment Information**


## **Education: College Enrollment Status**




