### NOTIFY

In the situation where a law enforcement officer may present in your office, department or classroom, please refer them to:

- The Office of the Superintendent/President where the warrant/subpoena will be reviewed and directed to the appropriate administrative offices & notify <u>Campus Safety</u> at your earliest opportunity.
- In the event that the President/Superintendent Office is not available, please refer law enforcement to
  - The Director of Campus Safety and/or
  - The Vice President Student Affairs for student related requests
  - The Vice President of Human Resources for employee related requests
  - The Vice President or School of Extended Learning for international student related requests



# **DOCUMENT & ESCORT**

Provide the President's Office with all details of immigration enforcement activities as soon as possible. Include time, location, officer name/credential, and details of officer's request, if known. **If you do not feel comfortable escorting officers, contact SBCC Campus Safety at (805) 730-4064 to assist.**
